The course design provides the maximum opportunity for learning through participatory and experiential learning processes that include structured presentations, case studies, and group work. <p>Strategic and Program Planning Includes an overview of epidemiology, population size estimation, WHO Rapid Assessment and Response and other data collection methods and data analysis. Outcome: Participants understand epidemiological and other bases for planning programs addressing sex work and HIV/AIDS.</p>	<p>Integrating Monitoring and Evaluation into Program Management Includes overview of methods, examples of processes undertaken by different types of interventions, ways of integrating monitoring with other program activities. Outcome: Participants understand monitoring and evaluation methods used in effective programs and gain skills in implementing these methods.</p>

<p>Principles and Practice of Effective Work on Sex Work and HIV/AIDS Includes exploration of principles; description of and evidence for effectiveness of interventions for HIV/AIDS prevention, treatment, care and support among sex workers, sex industry gatekeepers and clients of sex workers. Outcome: Participants understand principles on which effective programs are built and evidence base for various interventions.</p>	<p>Preventing HIV Transmission among and from Sex Workers Includes practical information on establishing and managing programs specifically targeting sex workers, sex industry gatekeepers and clients of sex workers: addressing outreach, empowerment, information-education-communication (IEC), 100% CUP, other condom promotion models; and advocacy. Outcome: Participants understand characteristics of main prevention interventions and gain skills in choosing appropriate interventions for their situation.</p>

<p>Integrating HIV Prevention, STI diagnosis and Treatment, and Drug Work among Sex Workers Includes practical information on establishing and managing programs to ensure integrated HIV prevention, STI diagnosis and treatment; prevention of HIV among drug-injecting sex workers and drug treatment for sex workers. Outcome: Participants understand characteristics of main integrated interventions and gain skills in choosing appropriate interventions for their situation.</p>	<p>Integrating HIV Prevention, Testing, Treatment, Care and Support for Sex Workers Includes practical information on establishing and managing programs to ensure integrated prevention, Voluntary Counselling and Testing, and HIV/AIDS treatment of sex workers; care and support activities shown to attract and assist sex workers. Outcome: Participants understand characteristics of main integrated interventions and gain skills in choosing appropriate interventions for their situation.</p>
